



1. The Cape Hope Foundation (CHF) brings together individuals, families and the business community in a co-ordinated effort to support worthy and focussed charitable programmes in Northern Tasmania. The emphasis is based, where possible, on youth programmes and on giving a “hand up” not a “hand out”.
2. CHF committee consists of 8 people who have lived and raised their families in the region.

 - Starting Point Neighbourhood House - The sustainable Garden Programme
 - The Launceston City Mission - Youth Mentoring Programme
 - Cancer Council - Seize the Day Awards enabling students to continue their education where their family is affected by cancer.
 - In conjunction with the Northern Midlands Council, CHF provides 4 education scholarships to enable 4 students to continue to Senior Secondary College (Campbell Town, Cressy, Kings Meadows and Prospect High Schools)
 - University Of Tasmania. - Springboard Scholarship assisting students to progress to further education.
 - Community Housing Limited. - funding of 2 scholarships to assist students in the northern suburbs to achieve personal goals.
 - Georgetown Neighbourhood House. - Fund Healthy GeorgeTown programme in conjunction with the State Government.
 - Loaves and Fishes - monetary donation was made to provide food support to people in need during the Covid 19 crisis in Northern Tasmania.
